

FAQ:

Question:

What happens when my child forgets their iPad?

Answer:

If your child forgets their iPad, they will be given a school iPad that will remain at school. If they forget it for a 2nd day, they will need to have a conversation about being responsible. If your child forgets their iPad for a third day, they will be required to use pencil and paper for the day.

Question:

What happens if my child's iPad is being repaired?

Answer:

If your child's iPad is being repaired, please send a message to the classroom teacher. We will then organise for your child to use a school-based iPad for up to one month. If the repairs are taking longer, please send another message to the classroom teacher to extend the time.

Question:

Can my child take school-based iPads home?

Answer:

No, school-based iPads must remain at school.

Question:

Can the school repair my child's iPad?

Answer:

The school does not have the resources to repair iPads. It's strongly suggested that you have the iPad repaired by an Apple authorised repairer.

Question:

All my photos have synced up in my child's iPad. How do I stop this?

Answer:

It maybe that you have signed into the iPad using your Apple ID. It's suggested that you set up an Apple ID for your child. This can be monitored and restrictions applied from your own Apple ID through Family Sharing. More information can be found here, <https://support.apple.com/en-au/102617>
