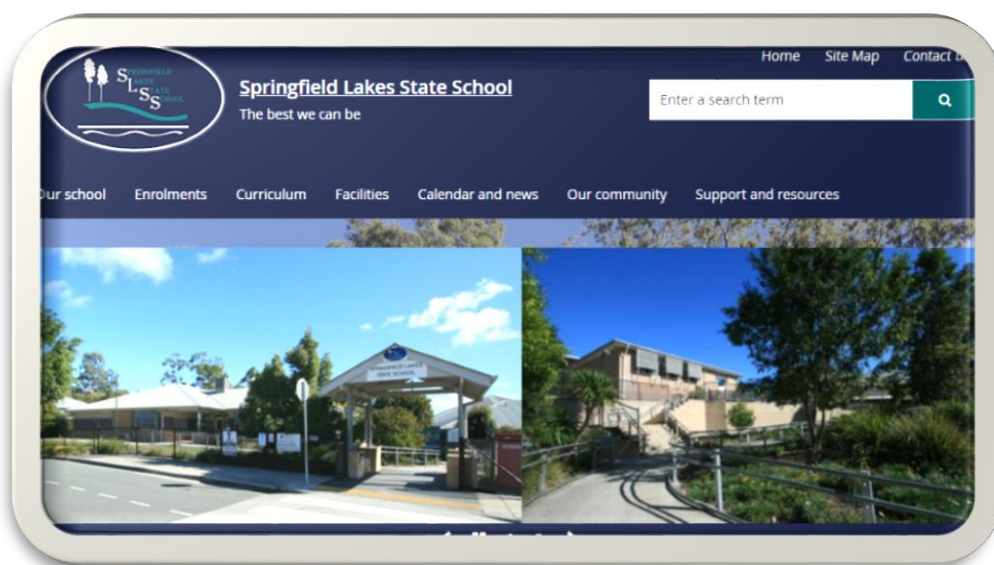


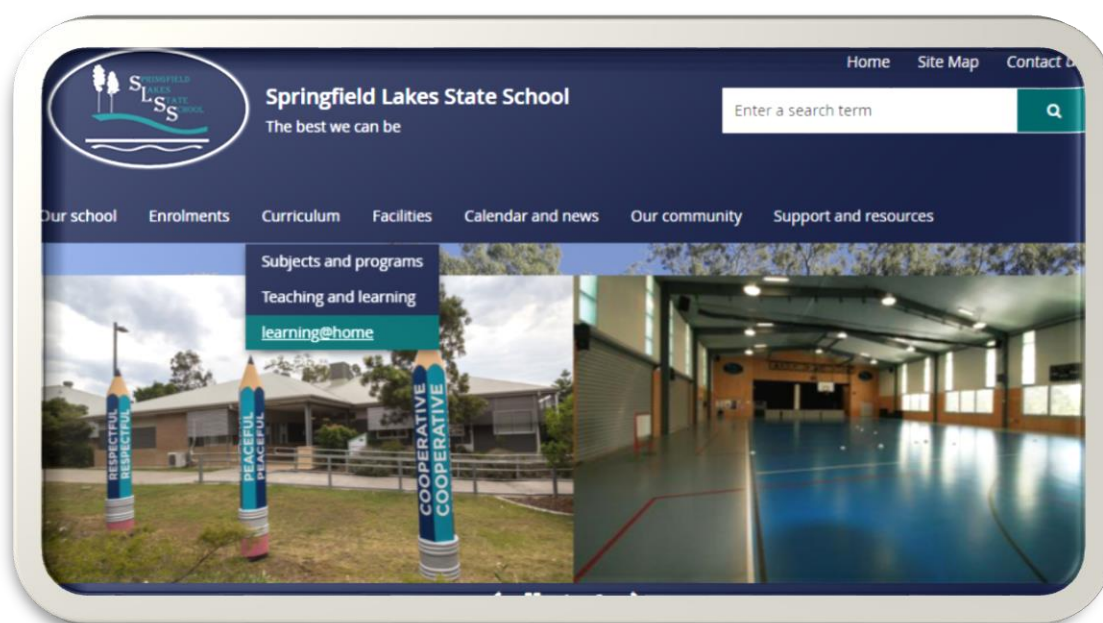
How to access Springfield Lakes State School's Online Learning

- Select 'learning@home' from the 'Curriculum' tab.



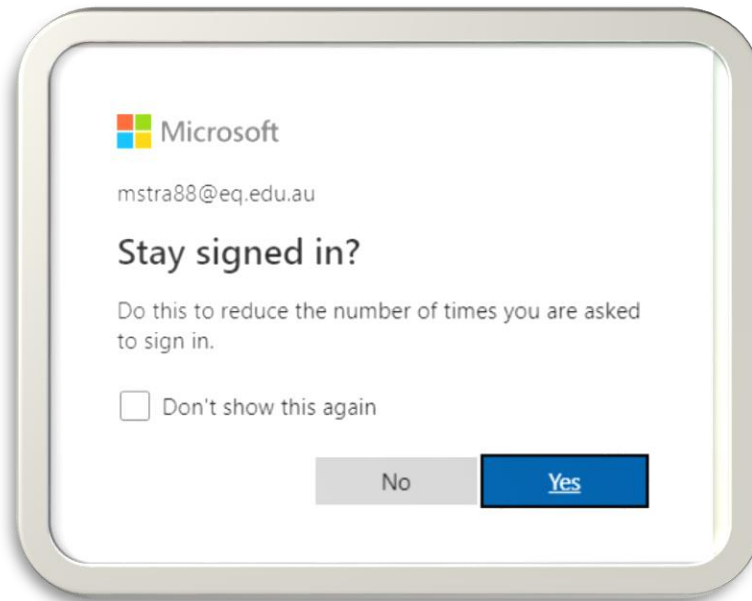
- Choose your year level
